

Summer 2018 Annual Teacher's Workshop "School for Barbarians, or, How to Raise a Nazi"

The 2018 Workshop examines how the Nazis used propaganda to indoctrinate German youth during WWII. This intrusive manipulation of children by the state began at an early age at home and was continued at school by teachers loyal to Nazi Party ideology. Propaganda also featured prominently in the organized and regimented youth group activities like Hitler Youth.

A Docent-led tour of the Museum will start the day, followed by the formal presentation session. The program will conclude with a summary of an interview conducted earlier this year with a SWFL resident who, as a young German student during WWII was forced to join the Hitler Youth. Artifacts and documents relating to the period will also be on display during the Workshop.
